



Enter the passcode and select "Submit"

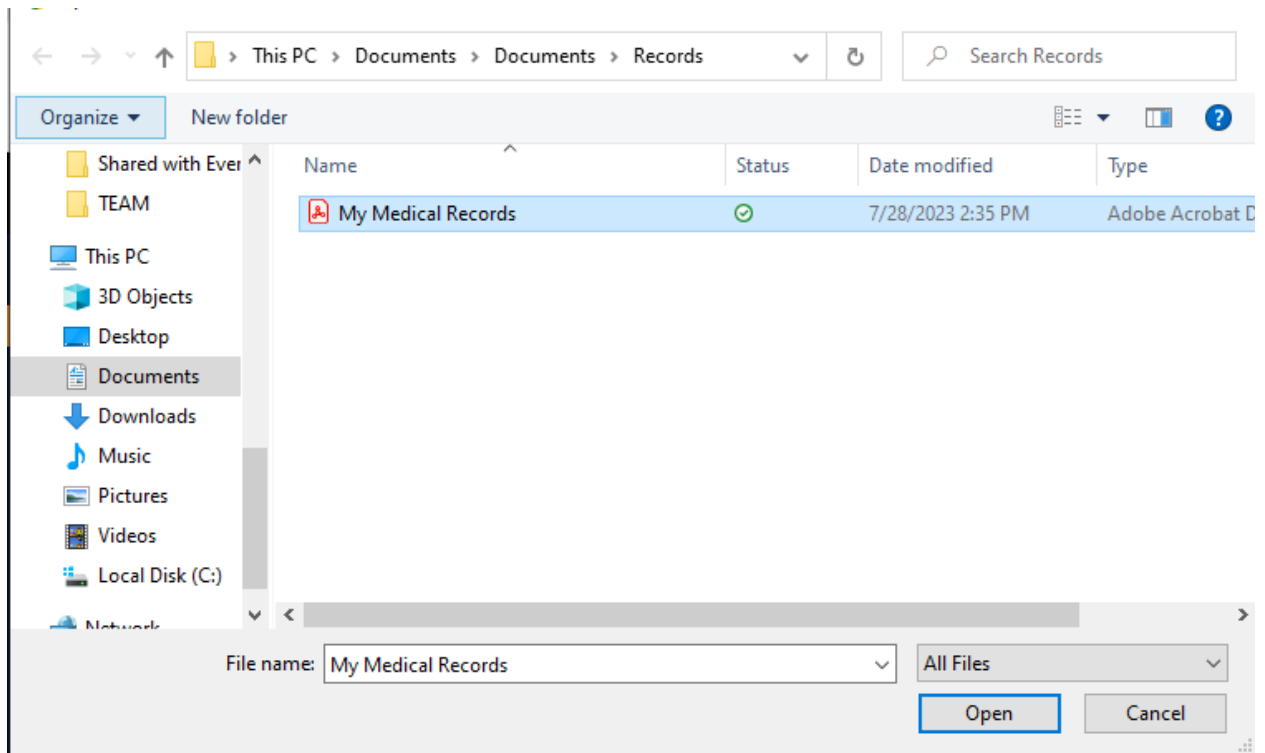
